Trips, key dates and other reminders:

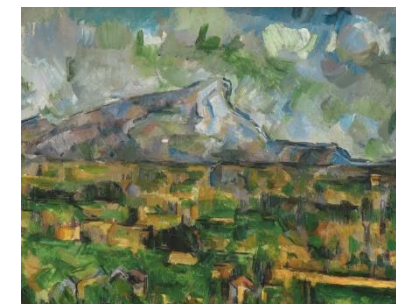
- Swans PE Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday
