Balanced arguments: Arguing a case from two opposing points of view. Oral debate on the use of the old Poundland site in Molesey. Oral and written discussion about the planet Pandora: Explore or Protect? Written discursive piece – should human beings explore outer space?

Reading: Balanced argument texts. Michael Morpugo: The Giants' Necklace.

Grammar: Using formal language. conjunctions, apostrophes for possession, modal verbs, parenthesis, ENPs for clarity and relative clauses.

Spelling: Year 5, 4 and 3 national curriculum lists and high frequency words misspelled. Spelling Bee and daily practice.

Games and PE

Crazy Ball: Developing quick response times and accurate throwing. Players work tactically to score by catching off a CrazyCatch rebound net. **Rounders:** Developing the principles of striking and fielding games. Fielding skills: throwing, catching and retrieving the ball. Performing the roles of batter, bowler, fielder and backstop.

RE **How did it all begin?** Exploring the similarities and differences between the creation stories of world religions: Buddhism, Hinduism, Humanism, Islam, Judaism, and Christianity.

Geography

Fieldwork: Using maps and how to use 4-figure and 6-figure grid references to find places. Creating a sketch map of my community. Collecting, recording and analysing data to help answer a geographical question.

Science

Animals including humans: The life cycle of humans. Gestation periods and foetal development. The time scale and characteristics of babies, toddlers and adolescents. Puberty and its effects. Adulthood and old age.

Calculation:

Number:

Comparing and ordering negative numbers. Understanding zero.

Measure

Kilogrammes and kilometres, millimetres and millilitres. Converting between units of measurement of length, weight and capacity. Converting between metric and imperial units of measure. Calculating with timetables and converting units of time.

Reasoning and Arithmetic:

Weekly practise.

PSHE Relationships. Being in an online community and staying safe. Online gaming and screentime. Recognising when I am spending too much time using devices. The rights and responsibilities when playing a game online, using social media or belonging to an online community.

D and T Pop up books:

Designing a pop-up book which uses a mixture of structures and mechanisms using sliders, pivots and folds to produce movement.
