NSPCC Assembly

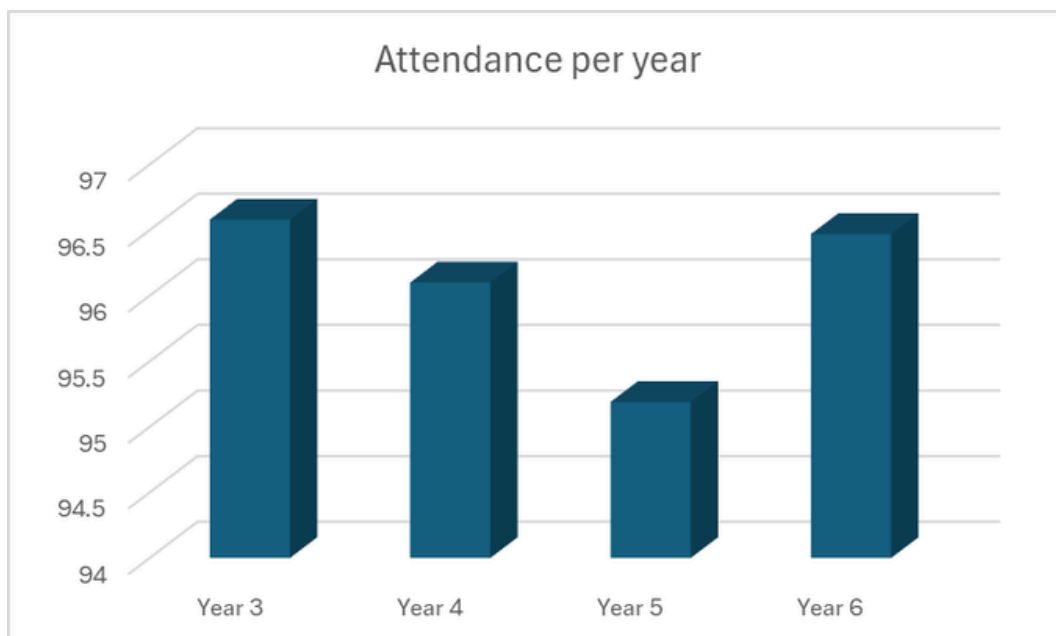
The children took part in an interactive NSPCC assembly this morning. Please do ask your children about this over the weekend. There will be follow up workshops next week.
